

ENROLMENT No. 201.

Permanent

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Wm. J. Russell of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Absalom Nelson and A. L. Lathrop of the same place, are

(each one third 1/3) sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Charles Smith of Buffalo, N.Y. whereof Wm. J. Russell is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Cleveland, N.Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Aug 21, 1871, numbered 32, now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and Sq. mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17.5 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 118 tons and 16 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said Wm. J. Russell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
