In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Charles Ensign of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Geo. W. Holt of Westfield, N.Y. are

(each one half 1/2) sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Buffalo, whereof Thos. H. Howland is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated June 4, 1864, numbered 278, now surrendered having changed owners. And said Enrolment, having certified that the

said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and that her length is 267 3/4 feet, her breadth is 35 1/10 feet, her depth is 14 2/10 feet, her height is 10 1/10 feet, and that she measures 1483 tons and 53 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Charles Ensign having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
