Y. in the year 1862, as appears by her last Enrolment at the Port of Rochester, N. Y. dated Nov 2, 1868. Numbered 385, now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment and District having certified that the said Banal Boat or vessel has one deck and sq. mast, and that her length is 96 feet, her breadth 17' 10. 10 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 122 tons and 29 hundredths, viz:
