In Conformity with an Act of Congress of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

A. L. Lothridge of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he, together with Absalom Nelson and Wm. J. Russell are

(each one third 1/3) citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Maggie of Buffalo whereof A. L. Lothridge is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Rochester, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by her last Enrollment at the Port of Rochester, N. Y. dated Nov 2, 1868, numbered 385, now surrendered having changed owners. And said Enrollment and Districts having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and sq. mast, and that her length is 96 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 122 tons and 29 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said A. L. Lothridge having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Act, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
