Y. in the year 1842, as appears by the certificate of Wm. Rosbinder shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.

And George H. Scriven, Surveyor said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17.9 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 125 tons and 62 hundredths, viz:
