

ENROLMENT No. 7. *Permanent*

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

R. A. Root of *Buffalo, N. Y.* having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~is the~~ *with* is Secretary of the *Western Transportation Co.* and that said Company, are

sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the *Montana* of *Buffalo* whereof *H. D. Heath* is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at *Port Huron, Mich.* in the year *1872*, as appears by her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of *Port Huron, Mich.*, dated *June 25, 1872* & numbered *114* now surrendered, vessel having arrived at her Home Port. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has *two* decks and *one* mast, and that her length is *236* feet, her breadth *36* feet, her depth *14* feet, her height *9* feet, and that she measures *1535* tons and *59* hundredths, viz:

That she is a Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said *R. A. Root* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo, N. Y.*
