John Blum of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with own two thirds (2/3) and that Geo. H. King of Huron Station which owns one third (1/3) and that they are

sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the *Abellie* of Buffalo whereof John Blum is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Huron River, Mich in the year 1867, as appears by her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago, Ill. dated Aug 31, 1871, No. 24, now surrendered, vessel having arrived home and said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 46 feet, her breadth 19 1/2 feet, her depth 6 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 59 tons and 38 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said John Blum having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
