America, entitled, "An Act concerning the registering and recording
of Ships or Vessels, William Mathbone husband or
managing owner

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said act,
and having sworn that he together with
Abraham A Skinner of Painesville State
of Ohio

are the true and only owners of the ship or vessel
called the *Widows Son of Detroit* (whereof John
Sturpley ^{having been born within the limits thereof} is at present master, and is a
citizen of the United States,) and that the said ship or vessel was
built at Chequamegon in the State of Ohio during
the year one thousand eight hundred and
Sixteen

And the former certificate of
Registry now Surrendered having certified
that the said ship or vessel has one deck and two masts and
that her length is fifty feet
her breadth sixteen feet and one inch and one half
her depth seven feet
and that she measures forty tons and seventy nine fiftys of a ton
tons; and that she is a Schooner has no gallery
and no head; And the said

William Mathbone, and Abraham A Skinner having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and
sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the
said Schooner has been duly registered at the port of Detroit
