In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enroling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

Joseph Sumack, of the County of Macomb, in the Territory of Michigan, Mariner,

having taken or subscribed the *Oath* required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a,

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner, or Vessel called the *Edgar* of *Detroit* whereof said *Joseph Sumack* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn, is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said *Shoop* or Vessel was built at *Salt Point* in the year 183/ as appears by

And *Joseph Sumack* having certified that the said *Shoop* or Vessel has *one* deck and *one* mast and that her length is *fifty five feet, two inches;* her breadth *sixteen feet, three inches;* her depth *five feet, nine and a half inches;* and that she measures *forty five* tons *eleven* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Shoop* has *no* Gallies and *no* head.

And the said *Joseph Sumack* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Shoop* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of *Detroit*
