In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes;" passed the 2d March, 1831, and Acts passed the 7th of July, 1838, and 3d of March, 1843, regulating Vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam. Also, an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is owner of one half (1/2) and Charles Henry of the same place is one half (1/2) owner and all

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the Marcellus of Mt Clemens whereof Peter Giblin is present Master; and as he hath sworn, is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Marcellus Michigan in 1849, as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Detroit the Eighth day of August A.D. 1851 number thirty three (33) now amended by reason of a change of Owners

and said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel is One Deck and that her length is fifty nine feet no inches, her breadth twenty feet no inches, her depth four feet six inches, and that she measures forty nine tons & forty nine ninety-fifths; and no screw or figure head: and the said John Stephens having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Detroit.
