In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes;" passed the 2d March, 1831, and Acts passed the 7th of July, 1838, and 3d of March, 1843, regulating Vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam. Also, an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

James Westcott of Chino, St. Clair County, Michigan

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the California of Chino whereof James Westcott is present Master; and as he hath sworn, is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Chino, Michigan in 1849, as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Detroit the Thirtieth day of September A.D. 1849 pursuant to Act of Congress of the 15th of August 1849, now renewed by reason of a change of Owners

and said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel is One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Seventy four feet six inches, her breadth Eighteen feet nine inches, her depth Five feet ten inches, and that she measures Seventy two tons ninety one ninety-fifths; and that she is a Schooner has a square stem and no figure head; and the said James Westcott having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Detroit.
