

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

R. J. Hackett of Detroit having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with *is a citizen of the United States and Secty. of the Western Transportation & Coal Co. of Mich. a body Corporate under the laws of the State of Michigan and having its place of business in the City of Detroit and that said Company are*

of the Prop. or vessel called the *Burlington* of *Detroit* whereof *Eugene Rathbun* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn *is a citizen of the United States,*

and that the said Prop. or vessel was built at *Buffalo N. Y.* in the year 18*57* as appears by *her Enrollment issued at this port numbered 112 and dated May 12th 1871. now surrendered having changed owners and reduction of tonnage. And said Enrollment* having certified that the said Prop. or vessel

has *one* deck and *one* mast, and that her length is *137* feet, her breadth *25* feet, her depth *7 1/2* feet, her height *10* feet; that she measures *276* tons and *50* hundredths, viz.:

that her official number is *A*; that she is a *Propeller* has a *plain* head and a *round* stern.
