

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

F. H. Fifield of *Waterford Oakland Co. Mich* having taken or subscribed the *vow* required by the said Acts, and having *sworn* that he, ~~together with~~ *is a*

Scow or vessel called the *L. L. Fick*, of *Detroit* whereof *P. L. Brown* is at present Master, and as he hath *sworn* is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Scow* vessel was built at *Trenton Mich.* in the year 18*74* as appears by *the Enrollment dated at Detroit May 2^d 1872 No 94* *not remembered having changed owners.* And *said Enrollment*

having certified that the said *Scow* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* mast, and that her length is *97* feet, her breadth *22* feet, her depth *6* feet, her height *113* feet; that she measures *113* tons and *50* hundredths, viz.:
