

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Quinlan O'Leary of *Detroit Mich* having taken or subscribed the *Oath* required by the said Acts, and having *Sworn* that he, together with *Timothy O'Leary* of *Same place* are equal owners

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Scow* or vessel called the *Melusa*, of *Detroit* whereof *Timothy O'Leary* is at present Master, and as he hath

Sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Scow* or vessel was built at *Port Huron Mich* in the year 1868 as appears by *Copy of her Enrollment dated Port Huron Mich April 16th 1869, now surrendered having changed owners and District* And *Said Copy of Enrollment*

having certified that the said *Scow* or vessel has *one* deck and *Two* masts, and that her length is *61* $\frac{6}{10}$ feet, her breadth *19* $\frac{2}{10}$ feet, her depth *5* $\frac{8}{10}$ feet, her height *10* feet; that she measures *39* tons and *59* hundredths, viz.:

that her official number is _____; that she is a *Scow* has a *Plain* head and a *Square* stern. And the said *Quinlan O'Leary* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Scow* has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Detroit*
